#	NAME	DESCRIPTION
1	American Association of University Women	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior girl with a minimum 3.0 GPA who, in an essay, expresses educational and career goals which demonstrate an appreciation of and a willingness to pursue the AAUW mission of advancing equity for women and girls through advocacy, education, philanthropy and research. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
2	The Patty Ahearn-Victoria Elementary School Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior from any Redlands Unified high school who has a 2.5 GPA or higher. This student must have attended Victoria Elementary School for at least three years and has continued to follow the Victoria Peace Builder's Pledge.
3	American Legion Aux #106 Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to an outstanding student with a goal to continue his or her education at a two-year or four-year college or a vocational training facility. The recipient should be related to a veteran. The student should provide the name of said veteran and the branch of military service he or she was in. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
4	American Legion Aux #650 - Philip Marmolejo Scholarship	This \$500 or greater scholarship may be awarded to a student with a B or higher GPA. The student must be a son, daughter, grandchild, great-grandchild, sister or brother of a Veteran. The student must provide the name of said Veteran and the branch of military service he or she was enlisted in and how the military has effected their lives. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
5	Frank G. Araujo Memorial Scholarship	One \$500 scholarship may be awarded to students of Mexican-American descent. The recipient must have a 3.0 or higher GPA, demonstrate good citizenship, and participate in school or community activities.
6	Arroyo Verde Elementary School PTA Scholarship	Four \$330 scholarships may be awarded to two graduating seniors who attended Arroyo Verde Elementary School all through elementary school. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and must have shown good character and citizenship throughout high school. Please write a short essay explaining your personal and academic goals as well as high school community involvement. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).

7	Assistance League Professional Women of Redlands, "PoWeR To Continue Learning" Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded by the Professional Women of Redlands, a committee of the Assistance League of Redlands, to a graduating young woman who possesses a minimum 2.5 GPA, has participated in at least one school activity, and has demonstrated some type of community service. Financial need is also a consideration. The recipient must be planning to attend a two-year degree or certification program or four-year college. Preference will be given to a student who will be the first in her family to obtain a college degree or professional certification program. A short essay must be attached on the topic, Describe an adversity you have faced and overcome and how this has helped motivate you to continue your education. Also, include a description of your participation in school activities and community service, evidence of financial need and why you want to continue your education. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
8	Beattie Middle School PTA Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Beattie Middle School, has a 2.5 GPA or higher, and demonstrates good citizenship. Consideration will also be based on the student/family participation in PTA/PTSA membership and activities.
9	Beaver Medical Clinic Foundation - Premedical Award	This \$4,000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who is seeking a career in the field of medicine. The student must be outstanding both academically and in leadership skills, ensuring success in his or her planned career.
10	Raymond and Donald Beeler Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student with at least a 3.0 GPA. Financial need is a consideration. The scholarship will be awarded to a student who will attend a community or a four-year college on a full-time basis.
11	Benchwarmers Club of Redlands Scholarship- Paul Duralia Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a three-year participant of the Citrus Valley High School sports program and has been a starter for at least one year and has exhibited good citizenship, volunteerism and dedication. The student must have maintained an eligible GPA.
12	Benchwarmers Club of Redlands - Greg Horton Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a varsity football offensive lineman with a minimum 2.0 GPA that has been a starter for at least one year and has exhibited good citizenship, volunteerism and dedication which are the same qualities exhibited by Greg Horton, shown by his big heart.
13	Blackhawk Spirit Boosters Award	Two \$300 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who have participated on the Blackhawk Spirit Team for at least two years, one of those being their senior year and whose family is a current paid member of the Blackhawk Spirit Booster Club. The applicant must plan on attending a two or four year college. One scholarship is awarded for academic accomplishments and the applicant must have a minimum of a 3.5 GPA. One scholarship will be awarded for school and community activities with demonstrated citizenship and character, the applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

14	Barbara Bonnema Memorial Scholarship	Several \$500 or greater scholarships may be awarded to students who show academic excellence as well as a financial need. The students must also be college-bound graduating seniors who will be attending school on a full-time basis.
15	Boy Scouts of America Troop 3 Art Till/Nathan E. Smith Memorial Scholarship	Two \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors with a minimum 2.0 GPA who plan to attend an accredited college, university, or vocational program. Continued involvement in scouting and community service will be considered. Preference will be given to individuals who have attained the rank of Eagle Scout.
16	Quincy Brown Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 or greater scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll as a full-time student in a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The student must have a 3.0 or higher GPA and have attended a Redlands Unified School District school for three consecutive years.
17	Nicholas C. Carter Memorial Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating male senior who has lettered in junior varsity or varsity soccer. Preference will be given to students who share Nicholas Carter's passion for soccer, culinary arts and/or military service. Applicants should present a 1 or 2 page essay demonstrating the impact that one of these interests has had in their life. The essay is intended to shed light upon the student's passion rather than provide a proficiency in writing. Students may feel free to include humor, recount personal events or find other creative ways to let their personality be the focus of the essay. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
18	The CASC Engineering Scholarship	Three \$500 scholarships may be awarded to outstanding graduating seniors who intend to pursue a degree in Engineering at a four-year college or university. Students pursuing any Engineering degree are eligible; preference will be given to qualified students entering a program in Civil or Environmental Engineering. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, demonstrate an interest in an Engineering career and be involved in community service and/or extracurricular activities.
19	Cesar E. Chavez Memorial Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has shown exemplary leadership, given community service, and shows financial need. It celebrates Cesar E. Chavez's legacy of compassion, education and equality for all Americans. Please write a short essay explaining how you exemplify his spirit and how you intend to further honor it. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).

20	Citrus Valley High School Aquatics Booster Club Scholarship	Four \$500 scholarships may be awarded to one male and one female water polo player and one male and one female swimmer that are graduating seniors. Students must have at least two years varsity water polo or swimming, have a 2 year CVABC membership and plan on attending a 4 year college, community college or accredited trade school. Applicants must submit an essay on "How high school swimming/water polo helped me achieve my educational goals and career objectives." Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
21	Citrus Valley High School PTSA Scholarship	These \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and be a member of CVHS PTSA. PTSA is a volunteer organization. Include an essay up to 500 words describing your volunteer activities within your school and/or community. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34)using CVHS PTSA.
22	James R. Clark Engineering	This \$1500 scholarship may be awarded to a worthy graduating senior with a minimum GPA of 3.5 and who shows financial need and community service. The student must be accepted and plans on enrolling in a 4 year program that leads to an engineering degree. Degree must be in civil, mechanical, chemical or electrical engineering.
23	Clement Middle School PTA Scholarship	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended and was involved in school activities at Clement Middle School.
24	J. and M. Cole Family Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has demonstrated good citizenship and is active in a local group such as a church or a community service organization. Must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and be attending college full-time. Students of an employed single parent and with financial need are given first consideration.
25	Contemporary Club Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who will continue to further his or her education in a career of his or her choice.
26	Cram Elementary School PTA Scholarship	Two \$300 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who attended Cram Elementary School for at least two years and have a 3.0 GPA or better. One scholarship is for a student going to a four-year college and another scholarship is for a student going to a two-year college.
27	Bobbi Cummings Music and Performing Arts Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student who has demonstrated a love of music and performing arts and intends to pursue a college degree in music or performing arts. Students must have a minimum 2.75 GPA.
28	Arthur H. Daniels Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior for citizenship, academic accomplishment, contribution to school and community, and future career plans. The student should be college-bound who plans to attend on a full-time basis.

29	Franklin Elementary School PTA Scholarship	This \$600 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Franklin Elementary School and has extensive volunteer service in both school and community. Academic standing and financial need will be taken into consideration.
30	Gail Garner Memorial R.I.S.E. Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student graduating through the Redlands Independent Study Education (R.I.S.E.) program from RHS, REV, CVHS, or OHS.
31	Bill Gibson Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has a 3.0 GPA or higher and plans to attend a college, university, or vocational school on a full-time basis.
32	Brian Glassco Memorial Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a student who has captained a varsity team, has 3.75 GPA or higher and has a love of history as demonstrated by passing an AP history exam. This scholarship is in memory of Brian Glassco and these were the qualities he exemplified.
33	Rachel Graham Memorial Scholarship	Several \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who will attend a four-year college or university on a full-time basis. They must have maintained at least a 3.0 GPA, shown good citizenship and participated in school and community activities.
34	Highland Grove Elementary PTA Scholarship	Two \$500 scholarships may be awarded to students that have attended Highland Grove Elementary school for at least 1 year. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and be a member of your high school PTSA. Submit an essay of 250 words or less on what you do to volunteer in your community. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
35	Robert J. Hodges CVHS Coaches Award	This \$1,000 scholarship may be awarded to a male or female student athlete whose positive attitude, respect for others, honorable competitive spirit and sense of team were key to the overall success of an athletic program. Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 and plan to attend a two or four-year college or university.
36	Annette and Ernest Keith Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who is in the top ten percent (10%) of his or her class and will be attending a four-year California college or university on a full-time basis.
37	Kimberly Elementary School PTA Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Kimberly Elementary School for a minimum of three years, is an average or above-average achiever, demonstrates good citizenship, and preferably has not received other scholarships.
38	Kingsbury Elementary School PTA Scholarship	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Kingsbury Elementary School for at least three years, has a minimum of a C average, and has demonstrated good citizenship and leadership. The student must show financial need. Involvement in extracurricular and community activities must be demonstrated.

39	Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation Academic Excellence Scholarship	This \$6000 scholarship may be awarded to a student with the following qualifications: an outstanding GPA upon graduation from high school, outstanding citizenship and extracurricular activity involvement with demonstrated leadership ability. The recipient will be selected through an interview processes conducted by the Kiwanis Club Foundation scholarship committee. This scholarship will be awarded over a 4-year period to a student planning on attending either a 4-year college or university or a 2-year college taking transfer curriculum. The award will be paid over a 4-year period directly to the recipient's chosen institution or to the recipient upon written request to the Kiwanis Scholarship Foundation, including a copy of the student's current class class schedule and a copy of a valid student ID. A completed signed student contact information card must be submitted to the Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation before the disbursement of scholarship funds will be authorized.
40	Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation Career-College Scholarship	This \$3,000 scholarship may be awarded to support a student at the post-secondary level in order to promote a skilled technical workforce. The criteria are a 2.5 GPA or better, a demonstrated interest and aptitude in a technical area, involvement in community service and/or extracurricular activities enrollment in a program of study that results in a two-year or four-year degree. This scholarship will be paid over a two year period directly to the recipient's college or technical school or directly to the recipient upon written request to the Kiwanis Scholarship Foundation, including a copy of the student's current class schedule and a copy of a valid college student ID. A completed signed student contact information card must be submitted to the Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation prior to the disbursement of scholarship funds.
41	Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation Community Service Academic Scholarship	Two \$4,000 scholarships may be awarded to students with the following qualifications: extracurricular activity involvement with demonstrated leadership ability, a high level of community service, outstanding citizenship, and a high GPA upon graduation from high school. The recipients will be selected through an interviewing process conducted by the Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation committee. This scholarship will be awarded over a 4-year period to a student planning on attending either a 4-year college or university or a 2-year college taking transfer curriculum. The award will be paid over a 4-year period directly to the recipient's chosen institution or to the recipient upon written request to the Kiwanis Scholarship Foundation, including a copy of the student's current class class schedule and a copy of a valid student ID. A completed signed student contact information card must be submitted to the Kiwanis Club of Redlands Foundation before the disbursement of scholarship funds will be authorized.
42	Friends and Family of Christopher J. Kohlmeier Scholarship	This \$750 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who plans to attend a two-year or four-year college or university and who has strong test scores, but whose C average in high school could easily have been higher. Preference will be given to a student interested in a career in law enforcement or firefighting.

43	Doreen Legg Memorial Scholarship	This scholarship of \$500 may be awarded to a graduating senior who will enroll full-time at a four-year college or university pursuing a business or teaching career. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and attended a RUSD High School for three consecutive years.
44	Owen Locke Memorial Scholarship	These \$500 scholarships may be awarded to students with a 3.0 GPA or above and who demonstrate financial need. Please note you may not have applied for other Owen Locke scholarships offered by an organization other than the RCSF.
45	Lugonia Alumni/Harrison Lightfoot Scholarship	Several \$1500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who attended Lugonia Elementary School. The students must have extensive community service and/or be involved in school activities, demonstrate good citizenship, and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. The scholarship may be used at any college, university, or vocational school.
46	Maximum Turbine Support Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student with a 2.5 GPA or higher and is planning on attending a trade school or 2-year college with an interest in a career as a mechanic, welder, plumber, electrician, fireman or nurse.
47	Moore Middle School PTA Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who attended Moore Middle School for three years and plans to attend college or a trade school.
48	Robert L. Morlan Redlands Area Interfaith Council Scholarship	This \$300 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior. The scholarship was created from the long history of promoting love and respect among all of the people of faith in our community. The student must provide a one-page essay using the following prompt: How I Can Be an Agent of Peace. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
49	Harry Munoz Memorial Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded in memory of Harry Munoz, a Redlands High School graduate of the class of 1940. Mr. Munoz lettered in four major sports and was a lifetime resident of Redlands and an active member of the community. This scholarship may be given to a deserving graduate who has demonstrated academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his/her education.
50	Rick Munoz Memorial Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded in memory of Rick Munoz. The recipient must have lettered in at least one sport in his or her senior year, as well as demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and a desire to continue his or her education.
51	Northside Booster Club - Felix R. Sepulveda Memorial Scholarship	These \$500 scholarships may be awarded by the Northside Booster Club to encourage athletes to maintain a good academic average. The scholarships may be awarded to a graduating male and female who have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA and participated in at least one sport.

52	Optimist Club of Redlands Scholarship - Marvin Duncan	This \$2,000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior girl who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, has a positive attitude, and has been involved in service to the community.
53	Optimist Club of Redlands Scholarship - Paul Duralia	This \$2,000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior boy who has a minimum 3.0 GPA, a positive attitude, and involvement in service to the community.
54	PCH Architects LLP - Steven J. Lehnhof Memorial Architectural Scholarship	This \$750 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who will be majoring in architecture or architectural engineering at an accredited college or university. It is awarded in memory of Steven J. Lehnhof, an architecture and drafting teacher at Redlands High School for many years.
55	Erick D. Potter Memorial	This \$1500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior with a 3.0 or greater GPA who intends to pursue a career in Engineering. Special consideration will be given to applicants involved in non-school service groups such as church or community service.
56	Redlands Administrative Personnel Association Scholarship	These \$500 or more scholarships may be awarded to the sons and daughters of members of RAPA. A screening committee composed of RAPA members will meet to determine the most deserving applicant, based on an objective scoring system.
57	Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth Scholarship	This \$350 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has participated in the Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth program, including scorekeepers or umpires, for a minimum of three years. The student must have exemplified good sportsmanship and academic achievement. Please include a 200 word essay entitled How Redlands Baseball/Softball for Youth Has Impacted My Life. Indicate how many years and in what capacity you participated, i.e.: Player, Umpire, Scorekeeper. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
58	Redlands Community Hospital Auxiliary Scholarship	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who will attend a college or university and major in some type of allied-health program. The recipient must be an active Redlands Community Hospital junior volunteer and must complete a minimum of 100 hours of volunteer service by the end of the school year.
59	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation - Honoring Ed Gleitsman Award	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior to assist in his or her pursuit of higher education in a business field.
60	Redlands Community Scholarship Foundation Awards	These \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors to assist in their pursuit of higher education.
61	Redlands Council PTA - Dorathy Jolley Memorial Scholarship	This \$400 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA and is active in a non-school service group such as church, scouts, or a community service club.



62	Redlands Education Support Professionals Association Scholarship	This \$1000 or greater scholarship may be awarded to the most deserving student within the Redlands Unified School District. The student must have a 2.5 or higher GPA, be the son or daughter of a RESPA member, and wish to attend an institution of higher learning. The student must present an essay in 100 words or less using the following prompt: What Education Means to Me. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
63	Redlands Evening Lions Club - Barbara Westen Memorial Scholarship	This \$350 scholarship may be awarded to help a deserving graduate pursue his or her training beyond high school. First preference is given to a student with a hearing or sight disability. If no recipient meets these criteria, the recipient must have scholastic ability. Financial need is also considered. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
64	Redlands Rotary Club Scholarship - Donald C. Anderson	This \$2,500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has shown the highest academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
65	Redlands Rotary Club Scholarship- Benjamin J. Rabe	This \$5,000 scholarship may be awarded to a student who has shown outstanding citizenship and service to school and community and intends to pursue a career in architecture or engineering. The recipient must be a current or past member of the Boy Scouts of America for at least one year. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
66	Redlands Rotary Club Scholarship - Ernest L. Cronemeyer	This \$4,000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior who has shown the highest in academic achievements, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
67	Redlands Rotary Club Scholarship - Edgar Fisher Memorial	This \$3,000 scholarship may be awarded to an active member of the Interact Club. High academic achievement and good citizenship are taken into consideration. The recipient will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
68	Redlands Rotary Club Foundation Scholarship	Two \$1000 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who have demonstrated high academic achievement, outstanding citizenship, and service to school and community. The recipients will be selected through an interview process conducted by the Redlands Rotary Club scholarship committee.
69	Redlands Rotary Club Foundation Discretionary Scholarship	These \$500 scholarships may be awarded to outstanding students who intend to pursue higher education at a two-year or four-year college.

70	Redlands Rotary Club Hatfield Family	This \$3000 scholarship may be awarded to a male or female student who has attended a school within the Redlands Unified School district from 1st-12th grade. Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 2.9 and plan on attending a two or four year college. Applicants must have outstanding citizenship and service to school and community. The recipient will be selected through an interview process.
71	Redlands Teachers Association Scholarship	Several \$500 scholarships may be awarded to graduating seniors who are committed to the profession of teaching. Recipients must be in good standing scholastically and have good citizenship. Qualified children with R.T.A. affiliations will be considered first.
72	Schools First Federal Credit Union Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior based on scholarship, participation in school and community activities.
73	Wilbur Schowalter Memorial	This \$1000 scholarship may be given to a graduating senior who has a minimum 3.0 GPA and has demonstrated a strong commitment to vocal music department through leadership, character, and musical talent. Preference will be given to a student planning on pursuing a music major in college.
74	Soroptimist International of Redlands Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to an outstanding female senior who has participated in community service and will be attending an accredited 4-year college or university, community college, or trade school on a full-time or part-time basis.
75	Melinda Stevens Alpha Delta Kappa	This \$1000 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating student who plans to become a teacher. The recipient must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, extensive community service and a passion for helping others. This scholarship is given in memory of Melinda Stevens, elementary teacher in Redlands. Provide an essay explaining why you would be worthy recipient of this scholarship. Applicants should include the information required by this scholarship using the specific essay listed on the Directory Page. (RCSF web pages 28 through 34).
76	Victoria Elementary School PTA Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship may be awarded to a student who attended Victoria Elementary school for at least two years and has been actively involved in community service.

82	Citrus Valley Social Studies Department Scholarship	This \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified student who has a 3.0 GPA, has maintained a B or higher in high school social studies classes and has accumulated 20 hours of community service. Student must demonstrate good attendance, have a clean discipline record, and have involvement in at least one extracurricular activity. Please write a one-page essay describing how your interest in social studies will pertain to your future studies.
